73/9	<p><b>Report from Cornwall Councillor P. Seeva:</b> Cllr. Seeva reported that Cornwall Council's initiative for safer roads, by introducing additional 20mph and 30mph limits, was gathering momentum, a meeting was to be held on 5<sup>th</sup> October to progress this matter. The next Full Meeting of Cornwall Council to be held on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Cllr. Seeva noted the Planning Application at Penhale had not been correctly displayed on the Portal, numerous inaccuracies were apparent. He would 'call it in' (i.e take to Committee) if the Planning Officer was minded to approve the application.</p> <p>He was disappointed that the application at Darite had been approve despite the objections put forward to the Committee.</p> <p>Cllr. Seeva agreed to contact Highways and request remedial action to the cattle grid at Common Moor which was seriously noisy when vehicles drove across it.</p>

75/9	<b>Planning Decisions received:</b> None at this time.	
76/9	<b>Reports from Committees:</b> Clerk vacancy: The HR committee had interviewed 2 applicants on two occasions. It was this committee's recommendation that Emma Luther be appointed to the role of Clerk and Responsible Finance Officer to serve this Council. Cllr. Prinn proposed acceptance of this recommendation and was seconded by Cllr. Harbord. Agreed unanimously. Clerk to contact the successful applicant.	Done. 23.9.21
77/9	<b>Speed Camera:</b> The battery operated speed camera currently installed proving to be unfit for purpose due to short battery life, consideration was given to conversion of the unit to Solar Power. It was noted that further research would be needed for effective installation of the new device to maximise its benefit. Cllr. Prinn felt an apology was due to Parishioners as insufficient research into various speed cameras on the market would possibly have revealed the shortcomings of the device purchased by this council. Cllr. Morris proposed the upgrade to solar at an approximate cost of £850 was the most cost effective way to enhance the performance potential of the camera, thus removing the need to manually change the battery every other day. This proposal was seconded by Cllr. Prinn. A named vote was called for: Cllrs. Prinn, Morris, Harbord and Andrews voted for the proposal, Cllr. Emms against, Cllrs. Sargeant and Smith abstained. Carried.	
78/9	<b>Skate Park:</b> It was noted by all that the progress towards installation of a purpose built skate park had been halted during the Covid 19 pandemic and it was felt that a working group be set up to re-start the project. As considerable time had elapsed since prices had been sought to build the skate park it was agreed that new estimates of cost should be obtained and the project be looked at by a working party made up of Councillors and parishioners. It was suggested that grant funding be sought to help with the cost of the project. Cllr. Prinn proposed a working group be set up, seconded by Cllr. Horsfield and agreed unanimously. Working group to include (suggested) Cllrs. Horsfield, Watson and volunteers from the Parish.
