<p>Situation:</p> <p>PC motion 34/2 of Feb 22 effectively ended the speed sign project on the basis that the project had no forecast of operational delivery, no estimation of final cost requirement to achieve operational delivery and no prospect of ever achieving any of the initial project outcomes. Cllr Price has successfully achieved speed sign function test and it is now in full working order. There is no requirement for any further financial expenditure to set the sign to work. All batteries, ancillaries and spares are available for a full set to work. System programming is available via existing mobile phone / laptop functionality. Installation of speed sign on existing posts is achievable within PC capability.</p>
<p>Background:</p> <p>After testing the unit with the upgrades, and in comparison, to the resale cost, it would be more beneficial to live test the system and make a decision on whether to keep it and use it at the pre-existing operation sites to gain traffic data and excessive speed data.</p>
<p>Assessment:</p> <p>No further cost would be needed from the council budget. The system is now set up and ready for deployment.</p>
<p>Proposed Motion:</p> <p>To proceed with the live test of the speed sign. PC to decide which location should be adopted for initial trial.</p>
