

## **Application for designation of a Neighbourhood Area – St Cleer Parish Council**

St Cleer Parish Council has applied to Cornwall Council to designate the parish of St Cleer as a Neighbourhood Area, in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012, with the intention to produce a Neighbourhood Development Plan.

If this designation is made, no alternative plan may be designated for that Neighbourhood Area until that designation expires or is withdrawn.

The Council is consulting residents and other interested stakeholders on the designation of this area.
